

A typical DSRas IT course

All DSRas IT courses are based on the way your employees use the software today and every aspect of each IT course is targeted exactly to each participant's wishes and your organization's needs.

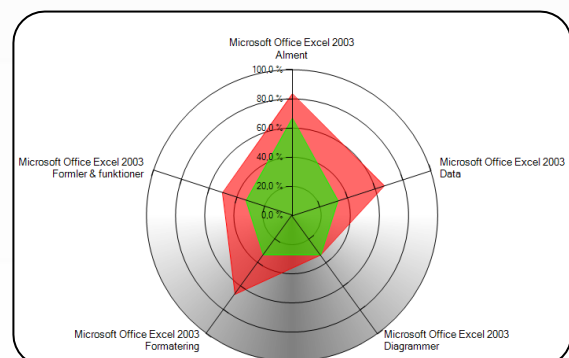
DSRas provides it all...

DSRas provides everything for the course or lecture so you do not have to spend any unnecessary time. From the initial planning and suggestions about content and duration to the different target levels of new knowledge within the specific software, DSRas will take care of it all. Online survey of competences

Normally, each participant will be offered an electronic survey of their competences and knowledge of the software in question prior to the IT course. The online competence survey takes about 12 to 15 minutes and will give both the participant and the organization a complete graphical overview of the areas and functions which are used correctly today and the areas which could be optimized to free time and avoid frustration during the workday. Each result from our competence surveys is linked directly to the subjects that we suggest for the employee during the IT course. This is to make sure that every participant gets the right training at the right level and aimed directly at the employee's day-to-day use of the software in the organization. Only this way can you be sure that your employees will not waste time with subjects that they already know or do not need in their work.



IT courses are normally held between 9 AM and 4 PM and are a mix of theory, exercises and dialogue. The training includes lots of opportunities to test elements and exercises either on your own PC or on the laptops set up by DSRas.

It would be an advantage to supplement the course with 4 weeks' subsequent, unlimited e-learning for training and targeted exercises (for Danish-speaking employees). DSRas' administration will handle ALL tasks in connection with the implementation of the course, from the initial competence surveys through invitations to the participants, requesting materials for course evaluation to the subsequent follow-up.
